

Raymond attended all twelve years of schooling in Sidney and graduated in 1945. In June of 1945, he was inducted into the United States Army where he served until he was honorably discharged two years later. After his discharge, Raymond started farming in partnership with his brother, Robert. They fed cattle in the winter and he also worked at the sugar beet factory. They sold the farm and purchased a home in Sidney where they retired. Raymond so loved working in his garden.

Raymond was a very faithful member of St. Matthew's Catholic Church and was a member of the Knight of Columbus.

Raymond entered the Eastern Montana Veterans Home in August of 2015 and he died early Thursday morning, July 28, 2016.

He is survived by: his twin brother, Ralph (Donna) Brown of Sidney, MT; his sister, Vivian Leischner of Billings, MT; many nieces and nephews.
