soul:

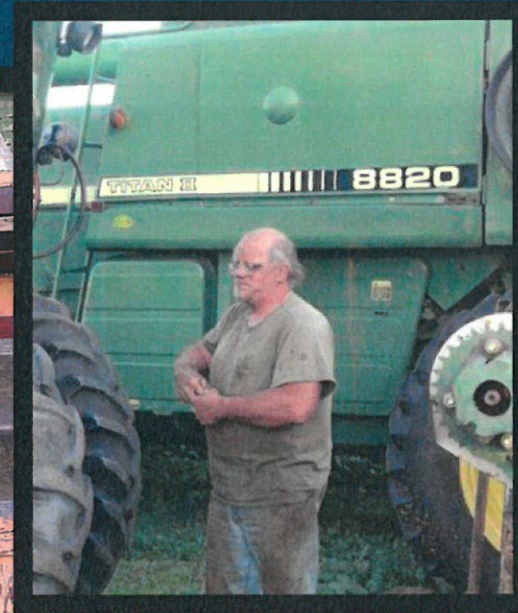
He leadeth me in the paths of righteousness

December 28, 1958 - January 12, 2017



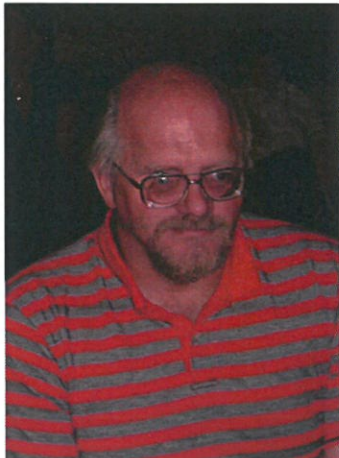
