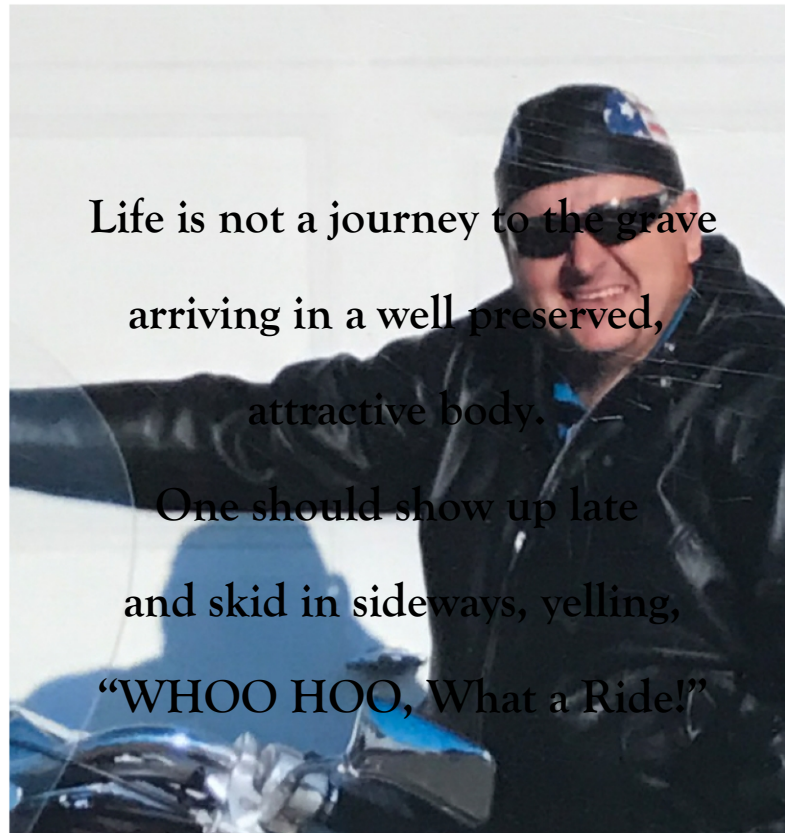




The Chain
