*If tears would make a staircase, and heartaches make a lane, We'd walk the path to heaven and bring you home again.*



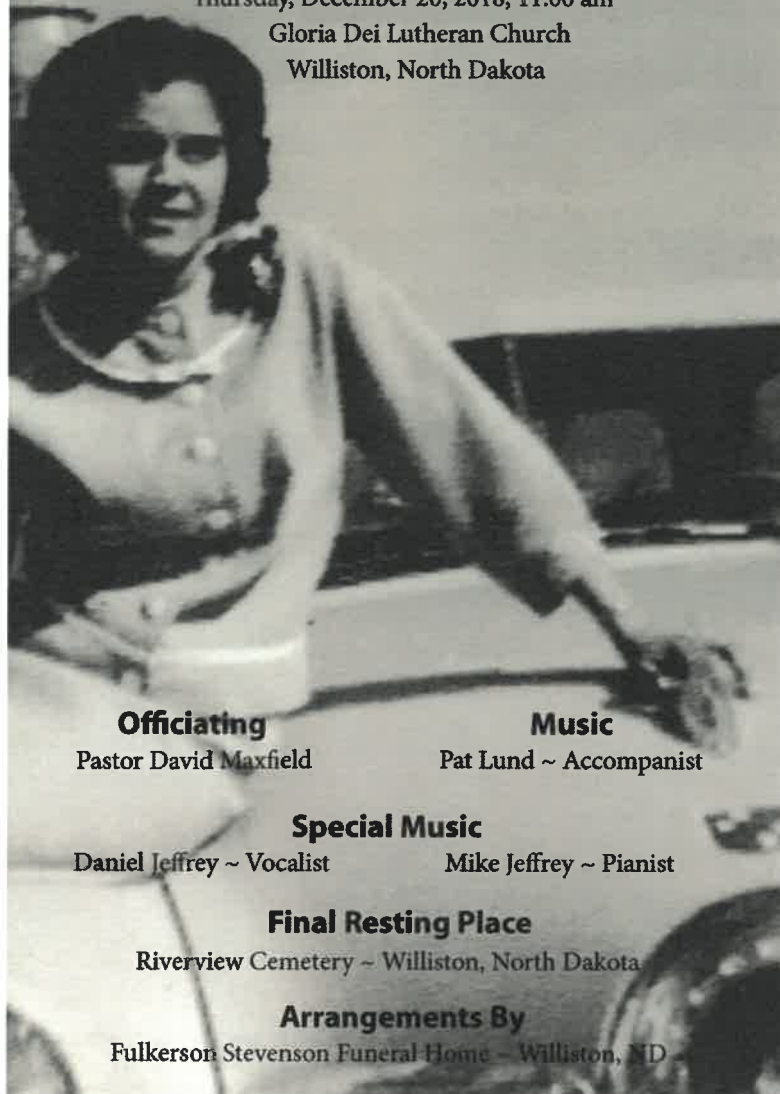
