Beulah was born on November 22, 1921 in Yankton, SD to Maude and the late Hermon Poellot. Maude remarried and put three of her children in an orphanage and kept Beulah, the baby. They lived near Omaha, NE until she was nine years old. It was around this time that Beulah went to live with Rev. Orie Dale Manning and his wife Jane. She attended school in South Sioux City through the 6th grade when the family was appointed to Wadena, MN. She graduated from high school there in 1941.

The family moved back to NE where she worked in a dry cleaning branch office for three years. She attended Kletzing College in University Park, IA graduating in 1949. Following her graduation she taught 1st grade for two years in her home town. During vacations she traveled teaching vacation Bible schools and attended camp meetings. In 1953 she assisted a widow in Sidney, MT where she met Elmer Gaffield. She returned to Nebraska to teach 2nd grade for one year before returning to Sidney to marry Elmer Gaffield on July 15, 1955. They made their home in Crane, MT until 1959 when they moved into Sidney. They cared for Rick, Debi and Mike Larson for a number of years. Elmer and Beulah adopted a baby, Patrick when he was 1 year old. Elmer and Beulah were married for 38 years when he passed away in November of 1993.

Beulah enjoyed baby sitting jobs, teaching VBS, Sunday School and Caravans. On August 11, 1999 she went on her first airplane ride to Nebraska. What a thrilling trip this was for her.

Beulah died on Wednesday, October 8, 2008 at the Sidney Health Center Extended Care Facility.

Beulah is survived by: her son Pat Gaffield, Sidney, MT; nephew Glenn (Marilyn) Gunsolley, South Sioux City, NE; three nieces, Phyllis (Leonard) Gontjes, Jane (Don) Huwe, Charlene (Jim) Knudsen; seven grandchildren and nine great grandchildren.
