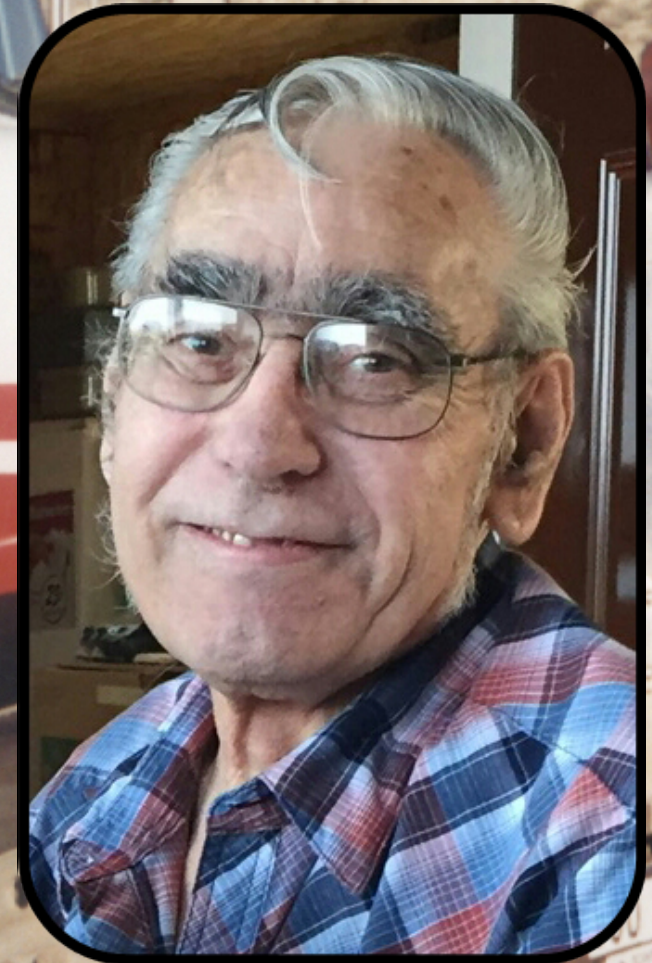
LeRoy died on Tuesday morning, May 17, 2016 at his home in Fairview, MT surrounded by his family.
