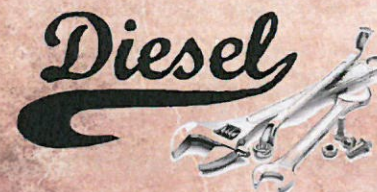


Our Father who art in Heaven
