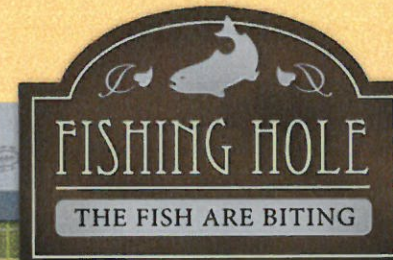
He was preceded in death by his grandfather Dennis Leinen and Uncle Ron Matthys.
