



Jamison "Jamie" Lloyd Wahlstrom was born to Denise (Dahl) and Craig Wahlstrom on January 13, 1991 at Mercy Medical Center in Williston, ND. Jamie passed away Sunday, June 4, 2017 in a tragic vehicle accident near Cartwright, ND.

Jamie attended kindergarten through 7th grade at Alexander Public School and 8th through 12th grade at Watford City High School. He grew up on the family farm and ranch, north of Alexander. As soon as he was old enough to drive a tractor, he was baling and running the hydro-swing.
