

Benny Lee Thompson was born on November 6, 1942, the son of Ben and Annie Thompson, in Powers Lake, ND. He graduated from Powers Lake High School in 1961.

He enlisted in the US Army in February, 1962. He was stationed in Germany and during that time, he specialized in driving tanks. He was a Marksman for Rifle M-1, Expert Rifle for M-14, Marksman for Pistol 45 and Marksman for TKcal. He was honorably discharged in February of 1965 and was in the reserves until 1968.

After serving his country, he worked on the family farm north of Battleview, ND. He was part owner of ABC Services out of Tioga, ND. He became an oilfield worker and farmer when he sold the business. His hobbies were restoring old tractors, wood working and reading.
