In 1959 Don married Rosella Guderjahn at Concordia Lutheran Church in Williston and that same year, began working for Northern Tank Line in Tioga, ND as a mechanic and truck driver. Don worked for Northern Tank Lines for 30 years, and then drove for Horizon Resources Prairie States Elevator until retiring in 2005.
