

During his time in the service he was honored with a National Defense Service Medal and Vietnam Service Medal. He received an Honorable Discharge in 1970 and came back to Watford City.

They fell in love and were married in 1981 and moved to the farm. After a nine year wait, together they had a Christmas blessing in 1990 when a beautiful baby boy named Douglas came into their life.
