
Big wheels keep on turning

He went on to attend two years at Rolla Technical Institute in Rolla, MO, specializing in construction. Austin would later earn certificates for operating forklifts and in welding and mechanics.

He was very active, he earned a 2nd degree black belt and in 1998 he was All State Karate Champion and in 2004 he won a Gold Medal Achievement in Royal Rangers. Boxing would become one of his favorite hobbies.
