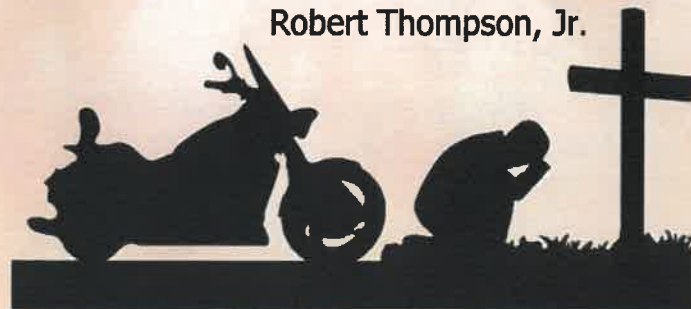
Hope Strength
