Mervin was so convincing, they believed it for a long

time, even though they knew they were 100% Norwegian. Mervin instilled in his kids a strong faith and that "Red, brown, yellow, black and white, they are precious in his sight." Yes, he was a man of few words, but taught his kids a lot. There were adventurous times on the farm as well, such as the time Mervin and his son Chris were trying to tag a calf when the cow knocked Mervin over and pinned im down, and he wound up with a broken arm. Mervin was pretty much blind for the last several vears, but no one would even know it, as he chased his kids down to get his "Weed Patch" mowed so he has a walking path to the feed shed and cow tank and he would still take the offering up at church. Mervin was still able to do "his chores" on December 26.
