

Kenneth Vesey was born May 10, 1921 to Benjamin Franklin and Eva Lydia (Kilbourn) Vesey on the family farm south of Blaisdell. He worked with his dad on the farm until he married Lillian Slind. Ken started his own farm not too far from his folks where he would hook up a team of horses and head to Blaisdell to buy the needed groceries. Milking 12 to 20 cows and selling the cream to buy groceries.

Ken worked at the rock crusher by Blaisdell besides farming. This was where Carolyn, Gail, Roger and Terry were born. On Friday evening Ken would take us all and go dancing, teaching all his children how to dance. On Saturday's we all would go to Stanley to go to a movie and popcorn.
