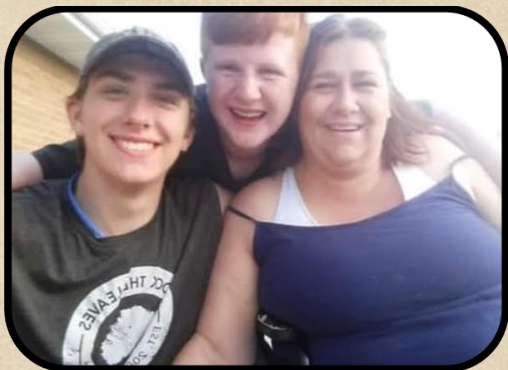
September 4, 1976 ~ April 15, 2021
