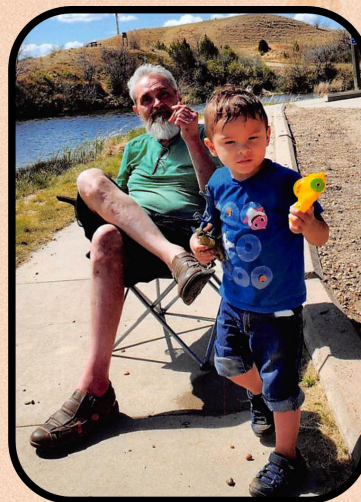
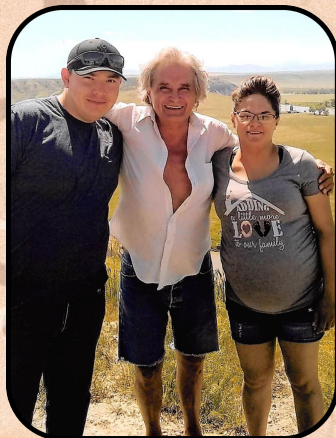
Pat is preceded in death by; his parents, Patrick and Delores; his uncles, Richard and Boone; his grandson Dylan, and Jackie Desjarlais.
