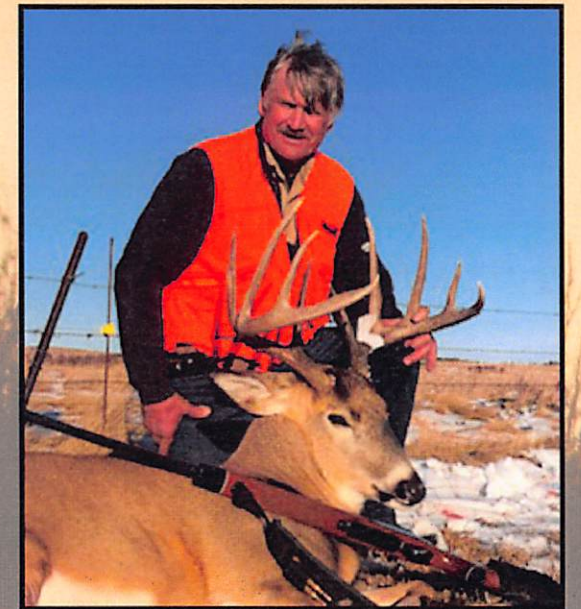

August 7, 1959 - November 25, 2021

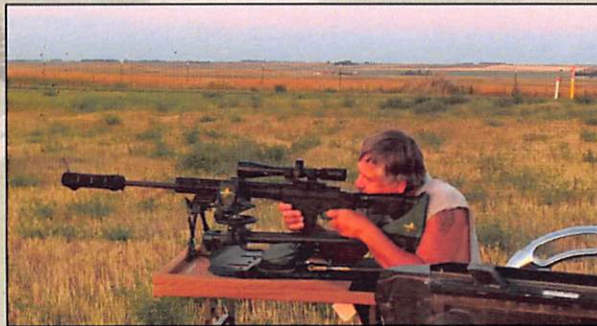
