

Effie was born in Sidney, MT on November 6, 1933 to Gus and Olga (Klempel) Nollmeyer. She was raised in the Savage area and attended elementary school at Midway, Junior High in Billings and graduated from Sidney High School in 1952. Following high school, she attended Eastern Montana College of Education, completing her teaching certification and taught all eight grades at Breeze Flats, a rural school in eastern Montana. On March 27, 1955 she married Everett Lowery, a Navy veteran who was employed by the Yellowstone Machinery Co. in Sidney. They later moved to a sugar beet farm out of Savage where she enjoyed raising a large garden and helping her husband with work in the fields and other chores. In the early 1970's, she and Everett moved to So. California for a couple of years and then returned to their farm in eastern Montana. Her husband, Everett Lowery passed away in 1974. Effie later moved to Missoula and married Clifton Waters there on September 23, 1979. They eventually resided in the Missoula Manor where she enjoyed playing the piano for some of the church services held there.

Effie was a special person to all who knew her and had a great sense of humor. She loved animals but was especially fond of the various cats that were a part of her life over the years. She had many friends and relatives who were dear to her and she always cherished their visits or hearing from them.

At the age of 12, she made the decision to accept Christ as her Savior and as baptized at the Baptist Church in Savage. As her health deteriorated, she looked forward to going to her home in Heaven and being with Jesus and loved ones who had gone on before her.

Effie passed away peacefully at her residence in "At Home Assisted Living" in East Missoula on December 22, 2008 following a lingering illness.
