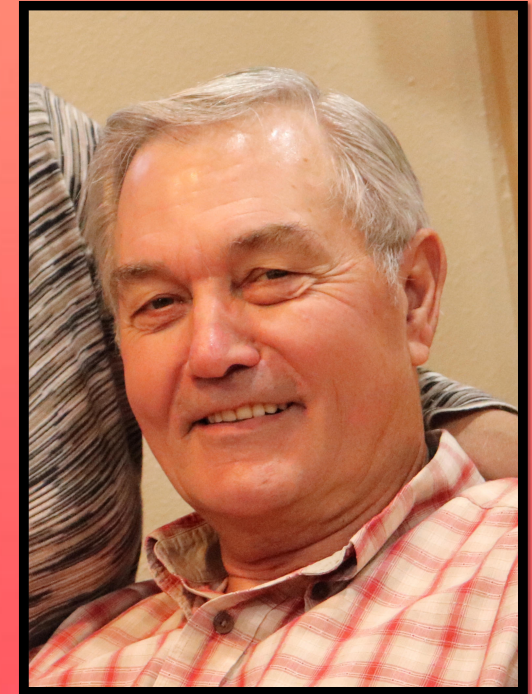

Ready to do it all.

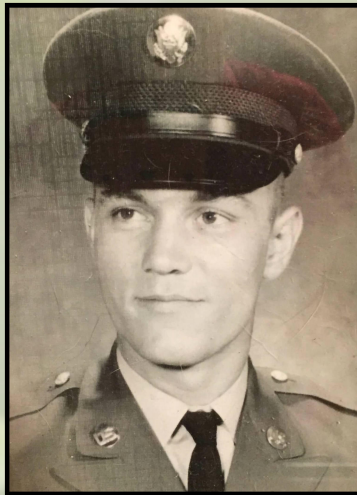
But God decided he needed you,
