



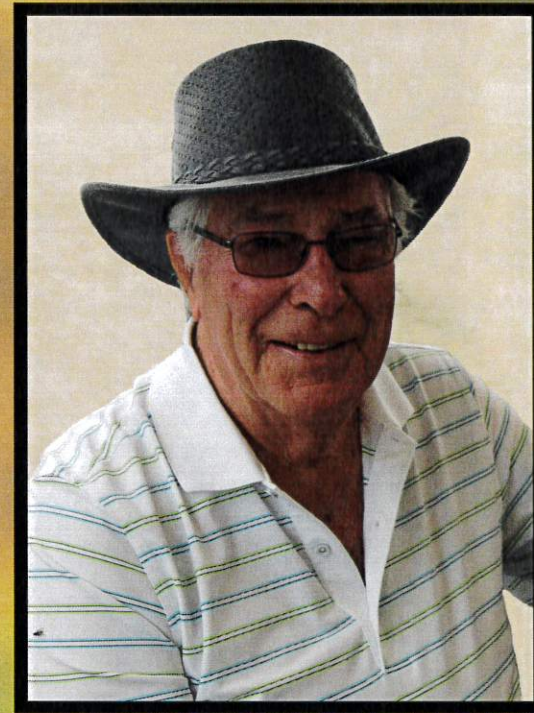
The Lord's Prayer
