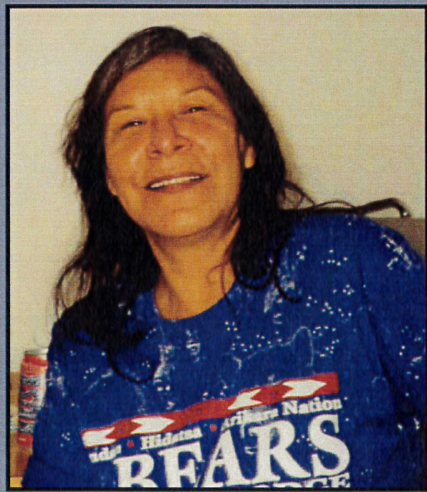
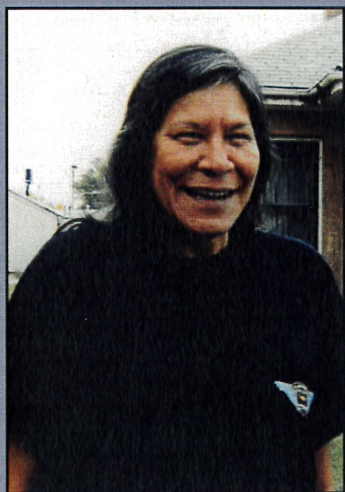
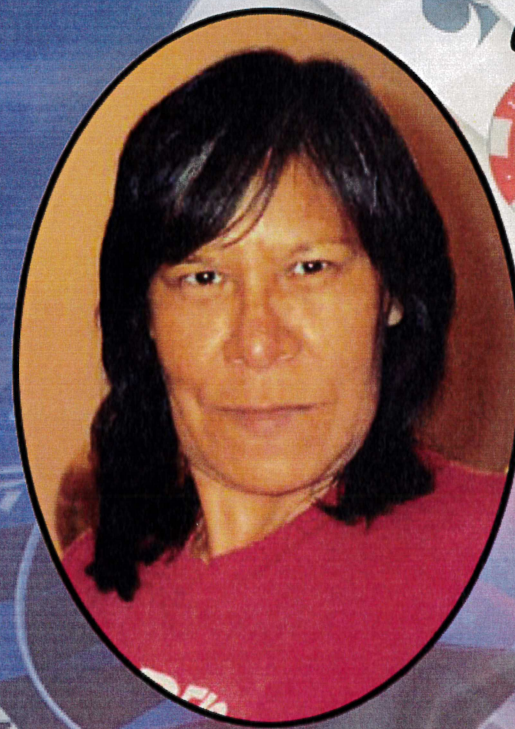


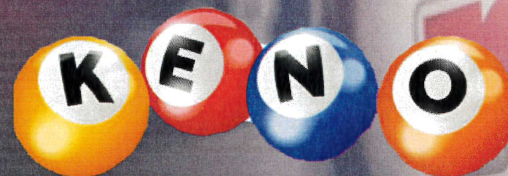
If roses grow in Heaven Lord
