

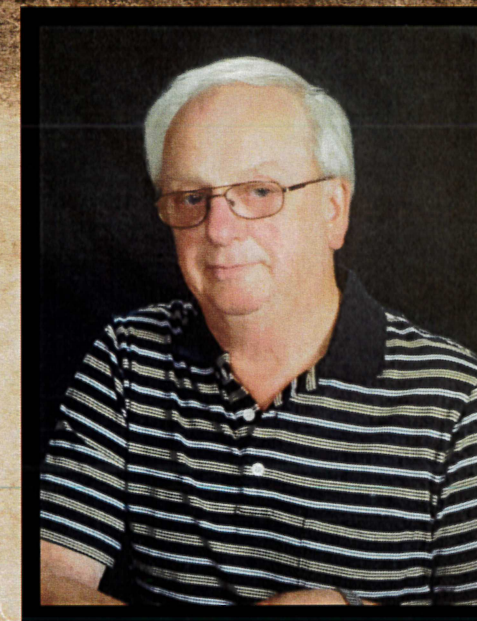


Chester (Chet) Ellwood Wolla was born April 20th, 1941 to Christ and Josie (Neset) Wolla in Tioga, ND. He was baptized and confirmed in the Lutheran faith. He attended the Wolla Country School through the 8th grade. Chet was united in marriage to Darlene Janette Anderson on April 20th, 1959, in Fargo, ND. Chet's work career was primarily centered around the oilfield. He spent over 25 years with Bethlehem Steel (Supply Division) and another 13 years with Harbison Fischer. 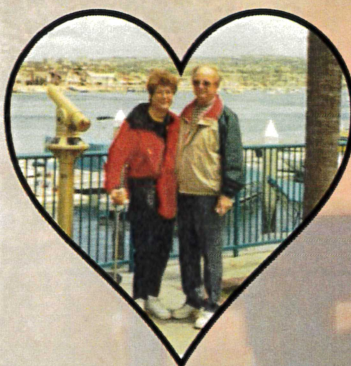
