


Not Enough Time

He will be missed dearly by his family and his friends. As he would say "Arrivederci, Ciao!" Until we see you again. We love you and miss you, Dad.

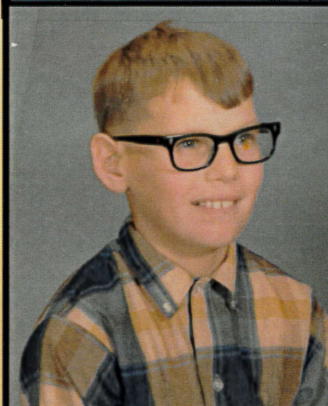
