Webster K Thackeray, 97 passed away peacefully on Saturday, January 6, 2024 at the Sidney Health Center Extended Care Facility in Sidney, MT with family by his side.

Webster was born August 9, 1926, to Jack and Lena (Leidig) Thackeray. He grew up with his brothers Leonard, John, Fred, and Raymond on the family ranch in the Bear Paw Mountains, south of Havre, MT. He attended nearby Lawlor Elementary school.

In 1947, Web went to work for the Great Northern Railroad. He was then drafted into the Army in 1950, and honorably discharged in 1952. He then returned to work for the railroad until 1955, when he went back to the ranch. Web served on the Bear Paw Volunteer Fire Department for many years.
