

In the later years after his grandchildren were born you would often find the babies in his arms in a rocking chair. Vernon preferred to stay close to home but he did go on several bus tours with his wife and in-laws. Vernon was a man who could fix anything, a man of all trades. Whether that be an electrician, mechanic, or a plumber he was a self-taught man and passed down some of these traits to his sons.

After Vernon was diagnosed with Alzheimer's in 2014 where he eventually went to live at the Tioga Long Term Care on April 5th 2016. During this time Norene was a devoted and loving wife spending nearly every day at the nursing home visiting and caring for him.
