for Thou art with me;*

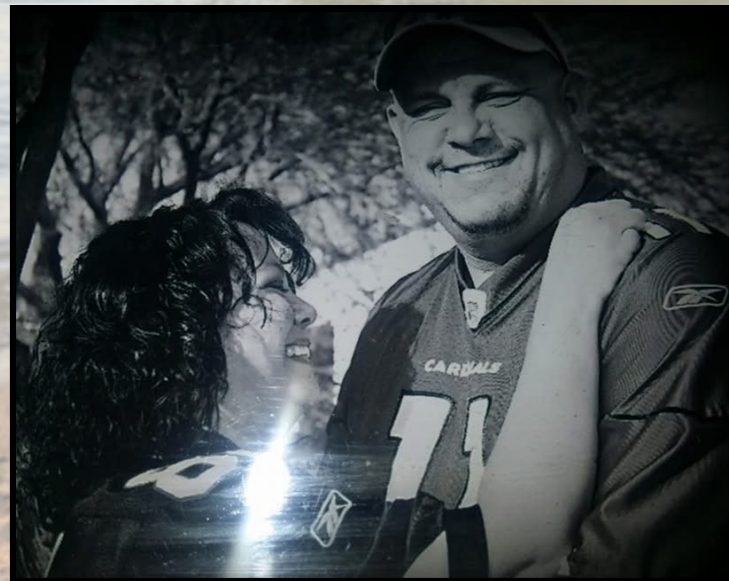

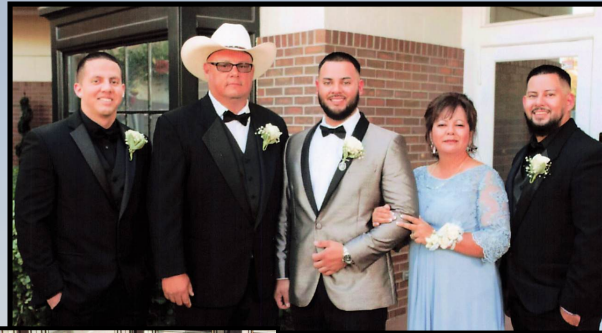


Keith Allen Hernandez
