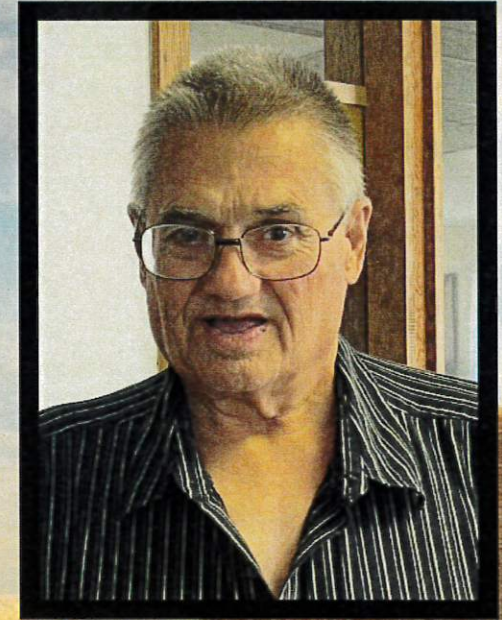
Bobby was a big football fan, the Minnesota Vikings were his team; he loved watching and talking about the games and players.
